Key Responsibilities:

- Managing the SHERQ budget and maintaining the SHERQ work processes, leveraging them across multiple units and functions.
- Ensuring resources are identified and utilized to successfully maintain the SHERQ processes.
- Maintaining effective communication with all local stakeholders.
- Coordinating the site emergency response plan with local authorities and mutual aid requirements.
- Implementing, documenting, maintaining, monitoring, and measuring of the health, safety, and environmental management system.
- Conducting incident and accident investigations.
- Ensuring all health and safety applicable legal appointments are documented, issued, signed, and maintained on record, with periodic updates as and where necessary.
- Ensuring all contractors are screened and inducted for compliance to minimum health and safety requirements and comply with the company's health and safety specifications.
- Ensuring compliance with COIDA (Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases act) and Rand Mutual Assurance (RMA) insurance processes
